Vista, California. For 20 years we have been using Boomshine to clean and polish our poles before they leave the shop. We decided to bottle up some and offer it to our loyal customers.

## HOW TO USE BOOMSHINE

We suggest you shine your boom in a well-ventilated location, not in direct sunlight.

- ◊ Open your graphite or aluminum pole
- ◊ Shake up the *Shine*
- ◊ Pour a generous amount on first rag
- ◊ Wipe *Shine* on the pole's tube sections
- ◊ Let it soak for less than a minute
- ◊ Polish each section with the 2nd rag
- ◊ Close your pole and use the residue on the dry rag to clean the collars
- ◊ Quickly wipe the rubber bumper

Keep your K-Tek pole clean... it'll last forever!
